SOUTH AUSTRALIA'S BEST IN TOURISM

Five of South Australia's finest tourism experiences have been inducted into the State's **Tourism Hall of Fame** at the [2011 South Australian Tourism Awards](#), after winning their category for a third year in a row:

- **Santos Tour Down Under** – *best Major Festivals & Events*
- **Getaways Reservation Service** – *best Specialised Tourism Services*
- **Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre** – *best Visitor Information & Services*
- **Seppeltsfield Vineyard Cottage** – *best Hosted Accommodation*
- **The Sebel Playford Adelaide** – *best Luxury Accommodation*

Producer, writer and presenter, **Ron Kandelaars**, with Channel 9's tourism and lifestyle program *Postcards*, was also honoured for his involvement in tourism, receiving the award for an Outstanding Contribution by an Individual.

Ron's love of a good story and the pride he takes in his craft; his genuine interest in the characters and tourism businesses; his ability to connect with interviews and audiences; and his ongoing commitment to promoting and fostering the SA tourism industry make him a worthy recipient.

More than 550 people attended the black tie event at the Adelaide Convention Centre last night, where **28 awards** were presented to businesses and individuals judged to be the most outstanding in their category (full list attached).

A **further 78 entrants** who achieved a high standard in their category were recognised with a gold, silver or bronze medal.

Tourism Minister Gail Gago congratulated all winners and inductees to the Hall of Fame.

"The awards showcase outstanding tourism events, operators and services in South Australia," the Minister says.

"I was highly impressed by the breadth of talent from the Outback to the coast.

"It's tremendous to acknowledge and celebrate excellence in the industry."

South Australian Tourism Industry Council Chief Executive Ward Tilbrook says an impressive **150 entries** were received this year, with almost 65% of our winners from regional South Australia.

“South Australia’s tourism experiences are some of the best in this country and South Australians should consider holidaying at home and book one of these award-winning experiences with confidence when planning their next escape,” Mr Tilbrook says.

The South Australian Tourism Awards are the pinnacle of excellence within the tourism industry; they reward innovation and foster better business practices by setting benchmarks for all tourism operators to aspire to.

The awards are judged in accordance with a strict set of rules and criteria, and winners will represent the State at the **Qantas Australian Tourism Awards** in March 2012, to be held in Cairns.
